Sunmax Programs for POWER POS.

- ****IMPORTANT**** ALWAYS DO A BACKUP BEFORE DOING EITHER OF Α. THE ACTIVITIES.
- If data on the same item (12345) is collected from different В. locations in your store/warehouse it will be summed during the upload process.
- The "Inventory Correction" funciton is designed for С. "cycle counting". That means that it ONLY updates items that are scanned. This also means that if you are doing a complete Physical Inventory that ONLY the items scanned are updated. The point is, that if your computer count on a specific item shows a quantity, but that item is NOT scanned because there are none on the shelf that item's quantity will NOT be updated because it was not scanned in. In order to get a correct inventory variance, items that are not scanned in MUST be updated to zero in the "Enter Physical Inventory" program manually.

USING THE SUNMAX

- Load the EZGEN and Com2000 programs from Sunmax(supplied with the 1. Sunmax).
- 2. Unzip these attached files into the EZGEN folder.
- Start EZGEN (supplied with the Sunmax). 3.
- Select "File", "Open", Type "POWER.EZG" Click "OK" Check "Setup", "Com Port" and adjust as needed. 4.
- 5.
- 6. Attach Sunmax 2001 to com port
- 7. Use instructions in Sunmax manual to clear program and data memory, then at Sunmax Main Menu select "3-Download"
- In EZGEN select "Download", "Program1" when the download completes 8. click "OK", select "Download", "Program2" when the download completes click "OK".
- The Sunmax is now programmed for both "Inventory Correction", program 1; and 9. "Inventory import", program 2
- 10. Collect the data and upload to the PC using Com2000(supplied with the Sunmax). For "Inventory Correction" save the file as "FILEREAD.TXT"; for "Inventory Import" save the file as "MYFILE.TXT". Once saved the file must be moved to the POWER folder for use.

DOING INVENTORY CORRECTION (program 1):

1. Use "Windows Explorer" to move or copy the "FILEREAD.TXT" to the "\POWER\" directory or folder.

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- 2. Start POWER POS and go to "Inventory Maintenance", "Updates", "Enter Physical Inventory", select store (if prompted), then hit <F3> to read in the file.
- 3. Go to "Inventory Maintenance", "Reports", "Inventory Variance Report", select the appropriate options, then POST.

DOING INVENTORY IMPORT (program 2):

- 1. Use "Windows Explorer" to move or copy the "MYFILE.TXT" to the "\POWER\" directory or folder.
- 2. Start POWER POS and go to "System Setup", "Importing", "Import Inventory Items", create the import profile shown below, then hit <F10> to SAVE. Hit <F2> and select "Sunmax" from the list with <ENTER>, then hit <Alt-I> to start import.
